Dear Mrs. Mackie:

Eden Village I and II are most appreciative of the goods (bread and pastries) donated to our single women and women with children during lunch and dinner. As you are aware Eden Village I provide temporary transitional housing to homeless women with children referred to as consumers for a 120 Day period. Eden Village I have been in operation since December 2008. Eden Village I houses 40 single female headed families. Eden Village serves 132 consumers at full capacity. Families with children from infancy to pre-kindergarten are offered free onsite childcare while participating in program. After School Care services are provided Mondays through Fridays for children age ranging from 5 to 12 yrs. In addition to After School Care, children age ranging from 5 to 12 yrs participates in Kid Mix held three consecutive Saturdays of the month. Tutorial and Youth Ministry is provided to the youth age ranging from 13 to 17 yrs. of age.

During tenure at Eden Village I, consumers are expected to collaborate with Case Manager weekly for the purposes of identifying barriers to maintaining housing and employment. Consumers participate in 120 Day Program via Levels. Level I indicates a consumer is employed full time and only addressing the need for housing. Level II indicates a consumer is unemployed, in need of both Vocational Training (12 week training) and housing. Level III indicates a consumer in need of addressing Substance Abuse or adopting a management plan for a diagnosed Mental Health Illness prior to participating in Vocational Training and identifying housing. Eden Village I immediate goal is to equip consumers with daily life skill tools such as Vocational Training, Parenting, Credit Counseling, Household Management, Financial

Management, Nutrition, Health & Wellness which includes Stress Management AND Self-Esteem, and any other services needed to return back to mainstream society.

Eden Village II a 90 Day Assessment Center for homeless single women. Eden Village II is a new addition to City of Refuge, Inc. Its operation began July 6, 2009. Program serves 100 homeless single women at full capacity. During tenure at Eden Village II, consumers are expected to partner with Case Managers weekly for the purposes of identifying barriers to maintaining and obtaining housing. Consumers of both Eden Village I and II attend various workshops hosted at the facilities.

Consumers are faced with homelessness for various circumstances. One circumstance for Consumer homelessness is affordability and economic sustainability. Many of the Consumers lack mainstream benefits to afford necessities such as food, clothing, and more importantly housing. The donation of bread and pastries deems to be beneficial to the women and families of both Eden Village I and II.

Thanks for your stewardship as you continue to serve our community and collaborate with us to improve our women and families quality of life.

To my Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It truly warms my heart to tell you of the blessings we have received over this past week. As you know on a daily basis we serve approximately 120 children ages 6 through 18. These children come from a low income, high crime area, which is plagued with prostitution, drugs, and violent crimes. The cases of child abandonment and neglect are astounding. Many of the children we serve are raising themselves and oftentimes have little to eat. Our memberships fees are very low and almost nonexistent, only \$25 for an entire school year and only \$150 for the summer program. Though we offer a quality program with highly trained staff housed in a safe and clean facility, we can not afford to offer the children we serve a daily meal.

Pastor and First Lady Mackie and the Keepin It Real Lighthouse congregation have truly been a blessing, providing bananas, milk, bread, pastries, and even clothes and toys. Today, Tuesday, April 13, 2010, Pastor Mackie also brought over 20 Honey Baked Ham bones. This truly was a treat! We are planning to make sandwiches for the children on Thursday as well as given a few of the hambones to some of our more needy families. The donation was truly needed and will benefit over 50 families.

I also wanted to include some of the quotes from the parents who have received some of the donations:

"Being a single mother, any extra help that I can get is truly appreciated. The weekly bread donation allows my kids to have a lunch every day. Once we even received macaroni and cheese, sometime a luxury at my house. I am just so thankful." - Kamesia F., mother of 3

"I have 4 children and my youngest son is a special needs child. My husband is currently out of work. The Boys and Girls Club has been a lifesaver, with letting me have a place for my children to learn, get help with homework, and play after school.
